OUR PROGRAMME

De-addiction Rehabilitation Programme

It's our continued programme. This year's we admitted 275 Patient in our Kanpur & Fatehpur center "New Morning De Addiction Cum Rehabilitation Centre-Nasha Mukti Kendra" which is run by Samuhik Utthan Sewa Samiti a nonprofit organization. We provide best doctor and psychiatrist to our patient in our center and we arrange the yoga teacher for yoga classes time to time for our patient. Within 10 days we arrange one counseling programme for avoid alcohol and other addiction to our center patient. Our center atmosphere is suitable for de-addiction and other alcoholism related diseases.

The involved operations are led under the leadership of Dr Hari Singh (MBBS, MD-Psych) & Dr. Sunil Gupta (BAMS). Under his experienced guidance and approach, our team (Dr. Arun Uttam, Dr. Sunil Gupta, Dr. P.K. Singh (Medical Examiner, LIC, Fatehpur) helps in understanding and providing solutions for Psychiatric and Psychological problems. Started with Acute management unit at 'New Morning De Addiction Cum Rehabilitation Centre' in Kanpur, we offer specialized treatment facilities for all psychiatric illnesses as well as other substance use disorder. We offer comprehensive treatment package for patients who have alcohol and drug dependence. 35 patients are discharge our center. The entire patient is completely healthy and normal and they're all simple living.

Health Programme



During these years we organized 3 Health checkup camps in district Kanpur, Kanpur dehat, Allahabad, Etawah, Auraiya, Mainpuri, Kannauj, Unnao, Hameepur, Banda & Fatehpur on 5th and 6th August, 2014 & 14th September, 2014 with joint collaboration with other NGOs working in the district. In block Patara, Kalyanpur, Sarsaul etc in these camps free distribution of medicines supported by Private Medical Stores. NGO staff also contacted house for community counseling related to health & nutrition. 200 to 500 people sum thing attending checkup camps.

Our Teams Dr. Hari Singh(MBBS, MD-Psych), Dr. Arun Uttam (BAMS), Dr. Sunil Gupta (BAMS) and Dr. P.K. Singh (Medical Examiner, LIC, Fatehpur) found that people of those area suffers from many communicable diseases like HIV, TB, Leprosy, Skin Diseases etc. Our extensive study showed that the level of knowledge and awareness about Health problem were extremely low among people in villages and slum areas.

Besides teaching English, the women's, children's & youth are involved in various extra-curricular activities like painting, drawing and sports.

Child Programme

In this regard Samuhik Utthan Sewa Samiti organizes draw competition for school children at SVBP Inter Collage, Saket Nagar, Kanpur on 29th August, 2014 and Maharishi Vidhya Mandir Inter Collage,

Jail Road, Fatehpur on 30th August, 2014 and Nagar Panchayat, Talgram, Kannauj on 2nd September, 2014. The topics in the seminar are Environment.

Students need to understand that there is a real threat to forests and wildlife. Everyone and the institution they are part of, has to play the assigned role to the best of one's capability to save India's forests and wild life. Apart from getting theoretical knowledge, they are given some live projects so that the students can have some practical experience.

Family Planning & Welfare Programme



We organize a one day family planning workshop at Nasha Mukti Kendra, Yashoda Nagar, Kanpur on October, 2014. This workshop was related with this most effective subject “Family Planning & Nasbandi” where our resource person Dr. Renu Gangwar also awared about PNDT ACT & Dr. Sunil Gupta (BAMS) told to patient and family that if we will do right and positive way then we will never fail in our life.

Skill Development/Capacity Building Programme



We organized Three months skill development programs at Sanjay Gandhi Nagar, Kanpur on 2nd October, 2014. This program designed to increase skills in your professional field while growing

intercultural competencies. Through continuous training and workshop, our programs will guide learners through a unique experience that will make them stand out to employers. Combining on-the-job experiential learning, structured reflection.

Consumer Awareness Programme

Samuhik Utthan Sewa Samiti organize awareness campaign programme at Kanpur, Chhibramau, Kannauj & Fatehpur on 5th, 10th & 29th October, 2014 are the common consumers in the country. Samuhik Utthan Sewa Samiti considers it of paramount importance to protect and safeguard consumer rights and to empower and educate every consumer so as to create an environment of quality culture and consciousness in the country.

Cultural Programme

Samuhik Utthan Sewa Samiti organized one day annual cultural Program at C.S.A Memorial Education Center, Yashoda Nagar Kanpur on 26th January, 2015 and SVBP Inter Collage, Saket Nagar, Kanpur for children with the support school. Children had came with thier parents. Vijay Kumar Singh (President of Samuhik Utthan Sewa Samiti) delivers the note of welcome to children and teachers, parents by stating the goal of the programme. We also organized same programme on occasions like Republic Day, Independence Day and Gandhi Jayanti to inculcate a sense of nation building and idealism.

Women Empowerment Programme

We conduct every year women empowerment courses. The courses offered in Tailoring & Beautician, typically range anywhere between 3 – 6 months, providing the students adequate knowledge to facilitate livelihood opportunities at the end of the training programme.

Technically sound trainers help and motivate the students to understand the smallest but critical technical knowhow of the desired skill development programme. The students are also provided tips on kick starting their livelihood through self employment opportunities.



Welfare of Old aged People Programme

Care of the sick and destitute is a complex process. The risks from disability, chronic illness and destitution are a process exacerbated by poverty and other forms of structural inequalities. Cultural patterns, prevailing attitudes and expectations - all need to be factored in while homing in on a model of appropriate care. We believe in ensuring that a person who is not fully capable of self-care can maintain the highest possible quality of life, according to his or her individual preferences, with the

greatest possible degree of independence, autonomy, participation, personal fulfillment and human dignity.

Adult Education Programme

We conduct adult education workshop time to time at our Kanpur center. Get information about the adult education provided by the Department of School Education and Literacy, Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD). Users can access information related to the background of adult education, literacy status, review of the National Adult Education Programme and National Literacy Mission etc. Information related to the Directorate of Adult Education is also given.

Adolescent Development Programme

Communication, Awareness and Advocacy encourages interaction and dialogue among adolescents, their parents and community leaders. Different types of forums with mothers, parents and community heads create the foundation for a supportive communication network. This formalized communication network not only helps ensure that the voices of adolescents are heard but also provides transparency to community attitudes supporting adolescent development. The community members in rural areas are often ignorant about children's rights, importance of girls' education and many other adolescent issues. Therefore it is essential to bring the entire community under one roof to raise awareness about adolescent issues.

Anti Female Foeticide Programme



Samuhik Utthan Sewa Samiti strongly believes in mobilizing an ideological movement against female foeticide, female infanticide and gender inequality in order to eradicate the social evils prevailing in the society since decades. There appears no quick and easy solution to the evils, but it is possible to reduce gender inequality, which lies at the core of female foeticide by challenging the patriarchal outlook of the society of bearing a male child and

to create a culture that celebrates equality.

Gender ratio is gradually decreasing every decade instead of getting equal. It is the most shocking fact that the innovative and high end technologies are contributing to killing of the girl child by determining the pre-natal sex test. The need of the hour is to realize our responsibilities and give a halt to this evil.

ICT Training and Workshops

Organization started computer training course for youth of rural and urban area of Kannauj, Fatehpur, and Kanpur center. Presently 65 women, children, youth are regularly attaining training of computer programming. The Course are Diploma in Computer Application & programming (Introduction to Computers, XP, Ms. Office (MS WORD, MS EXCEL, MS ACCESS,) Languages like C, C++, Tally) Diploma in accounting (Basics of Accounting & Tally), Desk Top Publishing (MS. Word , PageMaker, Coral Draw, Photoshop, Instant Artist), etc.,



The end of the programme Samuhik Utthan Sewa Samiti distributed the certificate to all participants.

Right to Education Programme (RTE)



Samuhik Utthan Sewa Samiti Organized awareness programme at primary school of Patara block, Kanpur on 5th September, 2014, the programme saw the presence of 85 students consisting of parents, teachers and academicians. Discussions on problems and challenges of Right to Education (RTE) implementation and its loopholes were held. All institutional members including president (Vijay Kumar Singh) are present in this programme.

Handicraft & Industrial Training Programme



The Samiti has conducted training programmes at our center, Kanpur. Needed women seeking a platform for developing skills offering them to livelihood opportunities. Organization offers training in skills such as Fragrance Stick & Dhoop Batti, Tailoring, & Beautician keeping in mind the weak education background of the targeted women. Center professionally run in terms of its operations and the course delivery. The students of the center undergo a rigorous skill training on the above mentioned skills for a period of anywhere between 3 months to 1 year based on the level of skill course/program enrolled for. The students undergo an examination at the end of the scheduled training and are awarded a Certificate based on the evaluation on successful completion of the training.

Self Help Group Campaign

Under micro credit program we have formed 50 SHGs in district Kanpur Dehat. These groups are formed under scheme of DRDA and NABARD. Through this program our Organization reached with 2500 villagers of 8 villages. These groups received training for management of Accounts, Skill development and Forward and back ward linkages to start their own enterprise. We also encouraged Banks to provide cash credit limit to our SHGs. presently our 50 groups received this facility. Under this program bank provided loan for Dairy, Masala, Agarbatti udhyog and other activity to SHGs.
