Our organization is committed to uplift the weaker part of the society. We are committed to undertaking various programs and activities for Women, Youth, Men and Children, Old age of the society irrespective of their caste, creed, age and religion, in rural, urban areas.

## *Our Programme*

### **De-addiction Rehabilitation Programme:**



We treated 181 Patient in our Kanpur center “New Morning De Addiction Cum Rehabilitation Centre-Nasha Mukti Kendra” which is run by Samuhik Utthan Sewa Samiti a nonprofit organization. We provide best doctor and psychiatrist to our patient in our center and we arrange the yoga teacher for

yoga classes time to time for our patient. Within 6 days we arrange one counseling programme for avoid alcohol and other addiction to our center patient. Our center atmosphere is suitable for de-addiction and other alcoholism related diseases.

The involved operations are led under the leadership of Dr Ankur Chakarborty (MBBS, MD-Psych) & Dr. Arun Yadav (BAMS). Under his experienced guidance and approach, our team (Dr. Arun Uttam, Dr. Sunil Gupta, Dr. P.K. Singh (Medical Examiner, LIC Fatehpur) helps in understanding and providing solutions for Psychiatric and Psychological problems. Started with Acute management unit at 'New Morning De Addiction Cum Rehabilitation Centre' in Kanpur, we offer specialized treatment facilities for all psychiatric illnesses as well as other substance use disorder. We offer comprehensive treatment package for patients who have alcohol and drug dependence. 166 patients are discharge our center. The entire patient is completely healthy and normal and they're all simple living.

### **Cultural Programme:**



Samuhik Utthan Sewa Samiti organized every year cultural Program at Baljeet Memorial Education Center, Dhaknapurwa T.P. Nagar, Kanpur. This year organised one day cultural program on 26th January, 2017. All children had came with thier parents. Vijay Kumar Singh (President of Samuhik Utthan Sewa Samiti) delivers the note of welcome to children and teachers, parents by starting the goal of the programme. We also organized same programme on occasions like Republic Day, Independence Day and Gandhi Jayanti to inculcate a sense of nation building and idealism. All the children participating

under the program were rewarded as well as teachers were awarded the organisation for giving better education to the children.

### **Computer Training Programme:**



The Organisation has been running computer training program for poor children for the last 3 several years. Through this programme 60 to 70 children take 3 months training per year. The main purpose of this program is to provide basic education as well as computer education to poor children. Organization started computer training course for children of rural and urban area of Fatehpur and Kanpur. Presently 60 children are regularly attaining computer training programme. The Course are Diploma in Computer Application & programme (Introduction to Computers, XP, Ms. Office (MS WORD, MS EXCEL, MS ACCESS,) Languages like C, C++, Tally) Diploma in

accounting (Basics of Accounting & Tally), Desk Top Publishing (MS. Word , PageMaker, Coral



Draw, Photoshop, Instant Artist), etc. The end of the programme Samuhik Utthan Sewa Samiti distributed the certificate to all students.

### **Mobile Repairing & Maintenance Programme:**



The Organisation has been running mobile training program for poor children for the last 3 several years. Through this programme 30 student take 3 months training per year. The main purpose of this program is to provide mobile repairing and maintenance training program to poor student. The area of Implementation Kanpur and Fatehpur District(UP). Presently 30 students are regularly attaining training programme. The end of the programme Samuhik Utthan Sewa Samiti distributed the certificate and motivate to all students.

### **Women Empowerment Programme:**



We conduct the Women/Girls empowerment vocational training program. The program offered deferent type of course like Tailoring & Beautician and other employment course. The course time period is 3 months. Provide adequate knowledge to facilitate livelihood opportunities at the end of the training program. Presently 90 Women/Girls are regularly attending this program. After training she worked to her home and earn some money.

Technically sound trainers help and motivate the Women/Girls to understand the smallest but critical technical knowhow of the desired skill development program. The Women/Girls are also provided tips on kick starting their livelihood through self employment opportunities.

### **Educational Program for SC/ST & OBC Students:**



Samuhik Utthan Sewa Samiti runs Educational Programme at Baljeet Memorial Education Center, Dhaknapurwa T.P. Nagar, Kanpur. The program started every educational month of year. The program specially focused on poor children education. The organisation has been spending the money on education of poor children for the last 2-3 years. They children who want to study and want to

go to school, but due to the some financial problem they not going to school. Organizations find children who can't pay fees for their school and want to read. The organisation pays annual fees of 30-50 children. The main purpose of this organization's program is to ensure that no any child in society is illiterate.

### **Welfare of Old Aged Programme:**



The organisation has contributed every year some necessary items like cloth, blanket, sleeper, furniture, fruits, food etc. required by old age persons. This year organisation has distributed 50 shawl and fruit to old age persons at viridha ashram, kidwai nagar, kanpur on 30th october, 2016. We hope our some contribution is helpful for the old person. In future organisation plan open new viridha ashram because we provide better services from other.

## **Awareness Programme**

### **Nishulk Payjal Camp:**

The collective effort of Samuhik Utthan Sewa Samiti and Baljeet Memorial Education Center, Dhakanpurwa, Kanpur, campaign a free water camp for the railway passengers in Kanpur Anwarganj station from May 25, 2016 to May 30, 2016. The passengers during travel often do not get cold water on the trains, stations, in the summer season, due to which there is considerable problem of water. At this situation we provide free water for train passengers. Through this program, free water distribution was provided to nearly 500 passengers per day and nearly 2000 to 3,000 passengers were benefitted.



### **Anti Tobacco Rally:**



About 70% to 80% of people in our country consumed tobacco. Knowing that Tobacco is harmful to our health, people still smoke tobacco every day. In order to make people aware of the diseases caused by tobacco consumption, the organization organized Rally on the occasion of World Anti Tobacco Day, which ended on the Affim Kothi to Anwarganj station. ### **Prabhat Pheeri:**



On the occasion of 15th August the organisation has conduct prabhat pheri rally with Baljeet Memorial education center children. Which the children of the center increased their participation and presents. Through prabhat pheri student were given social issues like freedom, teach daughter, women harassment, dowry system etc.

### **Diabetes Day Rally:**

On the occasion of world diabetes day the organization organized awareness rally in Kanpur city on June 14, 2016. The Chief Guest Mr. R. P. 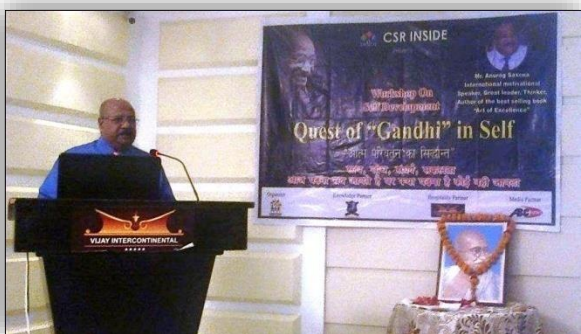
prisoners present that they would never do any kind of intoxication from today.
